- Animals who are sick should NOT be brought onto the fairgrounds. Livestock exhibiting signs of any infectious, contagious, or communicable disease ARE NOT ELIGIBLE for exhibition and will be refused entry. 4.
- Animals are not required to be registered but must be pure-blooded alpaca or llama. 5.
- Animals need not be owned by exhibitor. The same animal may be shown by multiple 6.
- Exhibitors must bring their own pens/enclosures. 7.
- The judge will conduct opening meetings with exhibitors to explain show criteria and the decisions of the judge and show officials are final.
